Summary

Paul Freeman v. Paladin Security Group Ltd.

The Complainant, Paul Freeman, filed a complaint under the Nova Scotia Human Rights Act alleging that the Respondent, Paladin Security Group Ltd., discriminated against him in the matter of employment due to his physical disability by not accommodating his departure from the worksite because of his degenerative disc disease. He was terminated from his employment shortly thereafter. The Respondent stated that the extent of his disability was not clear. The parties reached a settlement agreement for general damages.
