Summary

Stacey Gregory v. Vivian Deveau, Owner of Central Stations Hair Salon No. 51000-30-D10-1151

The Complainant, Stacey Gregory, filed a complaint under the Nova Scotia Human Rights Act alleging that the Respondent, Vivian Deveau, discriminated against her in the matter of employment based on sex, that her employment was terminated due to her pregnancy. The parties worked collaboratively to resolve the complaint through a restorative process, and a resolution agreement was reached in which Ms. Deveau agreed to implement measures to improve communication as well as develop training for human rights and other relevant issues. Ms. Gregory also received monetary compensation.
