

Summary

Scott Hewey v. 634623 NB Ltd (Peterbilt Nova Scotia)

No. 51000-30-H10-0143

The Complainant, Scott Hewey, filed a complaint under the Nova Scotia Human Rights Act alleging that the Respondent, Peterbilt Nova Scotia, discriminated against him in the course of employment due to a physical disability. The Respondent's position was that no discrimination took place. With consent of the parties a restorative inquisitorial hearing was conducted, and it was found that the alleged discrimination did occur. At a later hearing on the appropriate remedy, Mr. Hewey was awarded both monetary and non-monetary damages.
