Summary

John Hynes, Douglas Foster, Judy Wadden, and Mary Coffin v. Cape Breton Regional Municipality and CUPE Local 759 and 933

The Complainants, John Hynes, Douglas Foster, Judy Wadden, and Mary Coffin, filed a complaint under the Nova Scotia Human Rights Act alleging that the Respondents, CBRM and CUPE, discriminated against them in the matter of employment based on their age. The Respondents filed a preliminary motion seeking to limit the role of the Human Rights Commission in dealing with the scheduled preliminary motion as if it were a "neutral" party on abuse of process. The Board found the Commission to be a full party in the Board of Inquiry and its preliminary motion.
