Joseph Pye v. Commercial Safety Surveys Ltd.

No. 51000-30-H09-1344

The Complainant, Joseph Pye, filed a complaint under the Nova Scotia Human Rights Act alleging that the Respondent, Commercial Safety Surveys Ltd., discriminated against him in the matter of employment by harassing him by the teacher making racially harmful remarks against his aboriginal culture. A settlement agreement was reached which consisted of relevant training for the teachers, an apology to Mr. Pye and received general damages.
