

Summary

Tammy Quilty-MacAskill v. Community Justice Society

The Complainant, Tammy Quilty-MacAskill, filed a complaint under the Nova Scotia Human Rights Act alleging that the Respondent, the Community Justice Society, discriminated against her in the matter in the matter of employment on the basis of sex (pregnancy). The Respondent submitted that there was no discrimination and adverse treatment due to Ms. Quilty-MacAskill's pregnancy, and that her contract was not renewed for reasons relating solely to her performance. The complaint was dismissed.
