“... to identify and fund local and regional proposals to build the capacity of individuals, families and communities and strategic partnerships.”

DRAFT Innovation Fund Guidelines

Designed to get projects started and test out ideas that will foster community inclusion, dignity, and choice for people with disabilities.

- Reducing or removing barriers to joining community activities
- Increasing a sense of belonging and inclusion
- Providing peer support for and by people with disabilities to foster creativity, choice and control, and problem-solving
- Increasing awareness about diverse abilities and the value that people with disabilities bring to community
- Promoting inclusion in ongoing community activities, committees, and cultural events, as well as housing and transportation that isn't separate from others in the community
- Collecting or making available data, evidence and community insights on equity and ability-related issues

The total provincial budget is \$500,000, and it is available each fiscal year (April 1 to March 31).
